

TRIPLE BOGEY RULE

TRIPLE BOGEY MAXIMUM: No player shall score more than three (3) over par on any hole. Once a player has reached this threshold, she should pick up her ball for that hole, let the group complete the hole, record a triple bogey on the scorecard and move on to the next hole.

Example: On a par 4, once a player has hit her 7th shot, the player should then pick up her ball and advance with the group. Her scorecard would show a 7 on that hole.

Since we will be using the TRIPLE BOGEY MAXIMUM, USGA Rule 3-2: Failure to Hole Out will NOT be in effect.

REGIONAL AND STATE CHAMPIONSHIP: The Triple Bogey Maximum will not be in effect. Straight stroke play scoring will be used.
