#### **Parking**

The parking deck on the corner of McDowell & Cabarrus is \$8 and is the closest parking to the Raleigh Convention Center. Buses are to pull up to the bus loading/unloading area on Cabarrus Street and a convention center security guard will direct buses to their appropriate parking area (Lot G). All areas will have a fee to park, so please inform your spectators that they will pay to park anywhere downtown!

#### Admission

Spectator Admission will be \$10.00. Children 5 and under are free. Doors will open at 7:30 AM and competition will begin

## RULES -RALEIGH CONVENTION CENTER

The Raleigh Convention Center (RCC) is a stateof-the-art facility and is pleased to have the NCHSAA Cheerleading Championships in their venue! With that said, we are not the only group hosting an event in the RCC on Saturday, November 15th. PLEASE make sure that you inform parents, athletes, fans, and assistant coaches that the RCC is requesting that we stay within the Exhibit Halls/Arenas. Team bonding and meetings will not be allowed to take place in the lobby area. In addition, roaming throughout the facility will not be allowed. Restrooms are located throughout the Arenas as well as a "food court" with seating for eating! We have created everything you need inside Exhibit Halls/Arenas A, B, and C! Please understand that security will ask you to move inside the Exhibit Halls/Arenas on-site. Make it fun, be prepared and share this information with your fans so that expectation is clear! We do not want any athletes, coaches or fans discouraged by the RCC staff constantly telling them to move!

All spectators/cheerleaders/coaches must enter through the Cabarrus Street entrance to the convention center. The Marriott Hotel is connected to the convention center but the

connector/escalator to the convention



center will be closed! All must enter at the Cabarrus Street Entrance!

#### Registration

Coaches - We need you to check-in at Registration (front of Arena A) at least 45 minutes before your scheduled check-in warm up time (not your competition time but your scheduled warm-up time). Registration will be open from 7:30 AM until 7:00 PM and will be located inside the Raleigh Convention Center in front of Arena A. Teams MUST register by 7:00 PM. Please plan accordingly. Only coaches and athletes are allowed entry into Arena A at their scheduled warm-up time.

Two coaches (listed on registration form - two only) will be admitted free with each team. Coaching credentials/wristbands will be given at registration to registered coaches. Any teams with more than two coaches have paid \$20 per additional coach. If you do not have a wristband you will not be allowed in the warm-up room.

#### Warm Up and Practice Mats

Only cheerleaders and coaches will be admitted into the practice area (Arena A) at their scheduled warm-up time. Your warm up and practice time is listed on the Preliminary Order of Appearance linked to this update.


Music - 45 seconds of CHEER Please remember that a MINIMUM of 45 seconds of cheer is required within the 2 and a half minute maximum routine length. There is NO grace period. If you do not have 45 seconds of cheer (no music) within your routine you will be deducted 10 points and that is a huge penalty. This is a requirement specific only to this NCHSAA event. Please plan routine accordingly! I would plan on 50 seconds of cheer (you know they go faster on stage)! I can't stress this rule enough for this event. At this event, no team can afford a 10 point deduction so make it right for these athletes!

#### Playing your music

While your team is "on deck" waiting for their performance time, the person playing the music for your team will go to the music station to check their music. Please have at least two copies of your music. A standard CD or Ipod is accepted.

#### **Award Ceremony Protocol**

All teams will be called to the floor for awards and the top 1/3 will be recognized with trophies.



#### Scoresheets

Scoresheets will be given to teams during awards if they received a minimum score and earn a bid to compete at Cheer Ltd. Nationals at CANAM 2015. All other teams will pick up their Scoresheets in Meeting Room 205. Judges scores are final. Coaches, any questions or concern need to be sent in writing to Scotti Marshburn and will be addressed Monday, November 17, 2014. Judges are continually judging and will not be available for discussion.
