Players **cannot** lease a cart...they must walk. Coaches Cart Fee \$20.00.

Course Set Up: Play from **BLUE TEES**. Play the ball down. USGA Rules. Coaches remind player to repair all mark marks, rank bunkers.

Local Rules Sheet**

Disregard all other local rules except for the following

NEWLY SODDED AREAS

Any ball coming to rest **on** or **within** the seam of two (2) pieces of cut turf or against the edge of cut turf may be lifted without penalty and dropped at the nearest point of relief. Any ball coming to rest on the putting green and with backstroke being affected by newly sodded areas, a player is entitled to lift without penalty and place at the nearest point of relief. If nearest point of relief is off the putting surface the player must still place the ball.

OUT OF BOUNDS

Out of bounds is defined by the inside edges of white stakes and lines at ground level. During the play of holes #9 and #15, any ball coming to rest beyond the club house side edge of the cart path will be considered Out of Bounds even though the ball may come to rest on another part of the golf course (i.e. #10 tee box).

FLOWER BEDS

There is no free relief from flowerbed areas.

PREPARED VEGETATIVE AREAS

Ball must be found within this area while playing hole #1, to proceed under following local rule.

The prepared vegetative area left of #1 fairway and behind #5 green is considered **mandatory relief** without penalty. When playing hole #1, a ball hit into this area, defined by orange paint, must be played from the ball drop located down the left hand side of hole #1. When playing hole #5, a ball hit into this prepared vegetative area, defined by orange paint, must be played from the nearest ball drop to where your ball entered the area. The two ball drops are located behind the green and on both ends of the vegetative area.

FANS AROUND THE GREEN

Fans around the green are played as Temporary Immovable Obstructions (TIO). Player is entitled to line of play, swing and stance relief, nearest point no closer to the hole.

ROCKED LINE WALLS

The rocked line walls on 1, 6, 8 & 16 tee are played as immovable obstructions. A player is entitled to swing and stance relief.

ROPES AND STAKES SUPPORTING TREES

Ropes and stakes supporting trees are immovable obstructions. Relief may be taken **only** if a rope or stake interferes with lie of the ball, stance or area of intended swing.

WRONG PUTTING GREEN

The nursery green to the left of #1 and to the left of #9 shall be played as a wrong putting green. Relief is mandatory.

FOOTWEAR

Metal spikes are not allowed. Soft spikes only. The penalty for non-compliance is disqualification.

SHELTERS

In the event of rain or thunderstorms, shelters are located at #5 tee, and fairway of #7, #8, #11 and #12.

Playoff Hole

In the event there is a playoff for team or individual places the order of holes in the playoff will be Hole #9, Hole #10, Hole #15.
