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Men's Golf Coaches and Athletic Directors,

We had a question regarding the Regional Tie-Breaking Procedure for a team.

The Regional Tie-Breaking Procedure is as follows:

**If two or more teams are tied, go to 5th golfer's scores and compare. Lowest score wins. If still tied, go to 6th golfer. If still tied, must have playoff.**

The question is what happens if a team only has a 4 or 5 player team? If the 5<sup>th</sup> and/or 6<sup>th</sup> players' scores cannot be compared because a team does not have that same number of players, a playoff must occur.

If the course is unavailable for a playoff (weather, darkness, public play, etc.), the #1 players' scores from each tied team will be compared, lowest score wins. If still tied, compare #2 players' scores, lowest score wins. If still tied, compare #3 players' scores, lowest score wins. If still tied, compare #4 players' scores, lowest score wins.
