NCHSAA HALL OF FAME

I. PREAMBLE

The North Carolina High School Athletic Association Hall of Fame is dedicated to preserving the colorful tradition of high school athletics in North Carolina. The Hall of Fame seeks to highlight the past in order to insure a promising future for the North Carolina High School Athletic Association. The recognition of past personalities and their significant contributions to our state-wide organization will serve to provide models for future generations to emulate. Candidates will be judged on their long-term contributions to high school interscholastic athletics governed in the State of North Carolina by the North Carolina High School Athletic Association or the parent organizations which gave rise to the North Carolina High School Athletic Association.

II. SELECTION COMMITTEE

The Selection Committee shall be appointed by the Board of Directors of the North Carolina High School Athletic Association. The committee shall consist of representatives from member schools who occupy each of the following positions:

- A. Member of the Board of Directors
- B. Superintendent
- C. Principal
- D. Athletic Director
- E. Coach

These members may be active or retired. A member of the North Carolina High School Athletic Association staff shall act as an ex-officio member. Every effort shall be made to insure equitable representation from all areas of the state and the ethnic background of the Selection Committee shall be representative of our state.

Members shall serve three-year terms and the initial appointments shall be staggered to insure continuity of the Selection Committee. The Selection Committee shall be charged with making recommendations for inductions to the North Carolina High School Athletic Association Board of Directors.

Names of committee members shall not be publicized but the name of the chairperson shall be included in publications furnished by the North Carolina High School Athletic Association. The Executive Director or his designee shall serve to receive all correspondence and field all questions relative to the selection process.

III. MEETINGS

The Selection Committee shall meet in January of each year. Nominations shall be considered for formal induction into the Hall of Fame at the annual meeting of the North Carolina High School Athletic Association.

IV. NOMINATIONS

Nomination forms will be distributed by the staff at the regional meetings held at the beginning of each academic year included in the Formsbook, or mailed out as requested. Completed nomination forms shall be forwarded to the North Carolina High School Athletic Association office prior to November 1 of the same academic year.

V. AWARDS

Hall of Fame inductees shall receive an appropriate plaque and medallion furnished by the North Carolina High School Athletic Association and shall be formally inducted at the Hall of Fame Banquet. Space in the North Carolina High School Athletic Association office shall be set aside to commemorate the inductees.

VI. LIMITATIONS

There shall be no limit placed on the number of inductees selected annually.

VII. DECISIONS

Recommendations made by the Selection Committee and voted on by the Board of Directors shall constitute a final decision. The general nature of the criteria has been specifically designed to allow the vast majority of members to enter into candidacy. Future years may necessitate limitations on the eligibility criteria.

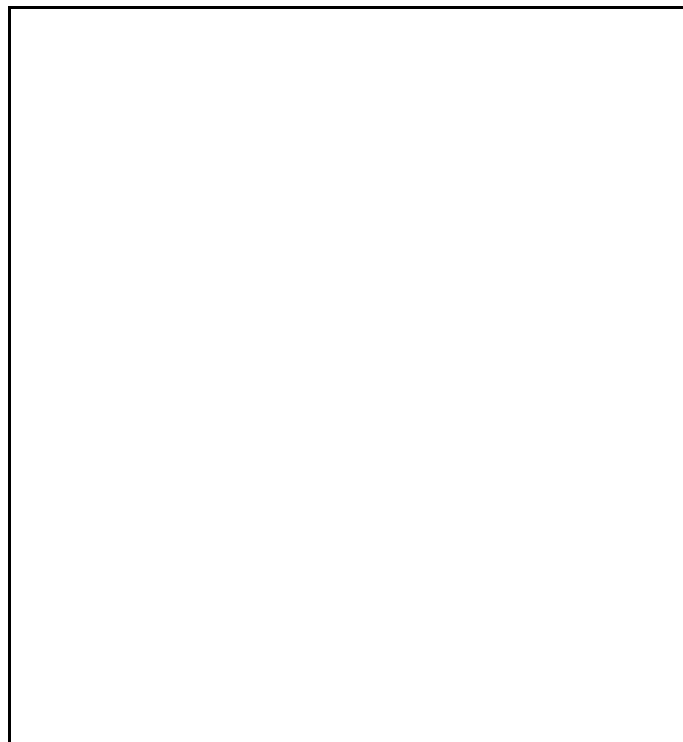
