

2016 NCHSAA MEN's 2A Regional Tournament Rules

- USGA rules will govern all play. The ball must be played down and all putts must be holed.
- You will be playing the **BLACK** tee markers.
- If you require a ruling:
 - Ask for Rules Official to respond to make an official decision. If the Rules Official is unavailable, then play two balls and a decision will be made at the end of your round.
 - If you suspect your first tee shot is out of bounds, please play a declared provisional ball **before** you leave the teeing area. This ensures pace of play is kept up and players do not have to return to the tee in the event the first ball cannot be found.
- Please turn in your scorecard at the pavilion immediately following play.

LOCAL RULES

- Any shot traveling left of the ponds on the 17th hole, or left of the white stakes, is considered out of bounds. (white stakes and white lines extend from the 1st pond to the 2nd). The aforementioned rules **do not** apply to shots taken on hole #18.
- On Hole #16: **For the Tee Shot Only**, any ball crossing the hazard on the left (other side of the creek) is out of bounds.
- Any ball coming to rest on or across a paved road is considered **OUT OF BOUNDS**.
- On Hole #6, any ball within the driving range is considered **OUT OF BOUNDS**.
- Out of Bounds will be marked by white stakes or a paved road on all holes.
- The flower bed behind #6 green is considered a manicured area. The player may take free relief from this area in the drop circle provided behind the green.
- For hole #9, the large fairway bunker (located down the left side beside the driving range) will be played as a **BUNKER**.

- High grass on holes 10, 12, 13, and 18 are played as lateral hazards. The margin of the hazard begins where the tall grass begins.
