Saturday, November 19, 2016**

The 72<sup>nd</sup> Annual WRAL Raleigh Christmas Parade will be held downtown Raleigh on Saturday, November 19. The parade is 10am – 12N so be aware that traffic will be greatly affected from about 8:30am until after the parade has cleared out.

With this in mind, this map should assist you in getting to the Performing Arts Parking Deck across Lenoir St., adjacent to the Raleigh Convention Center.

Note that the easiest access to the Performing Arts Parking Deck is off South Street. If you are coming from any other section of Raleigh, it's best that you loop around to the south side of Raleigh to exit #298 off I-40 and turn towards downtown. At about 1 mile there will be a barricade that will force you to bear right onto Western Blvd./Martin Luther King Blvd. off of McDowell St. If the barricade is there, no traffic is allowed in the downtown area, at that time. You need to bear right as required. At the top of the exit turn right onto MLK Blvd. At the next light turn left onto Wilmington St. At the next light turn left onto South St. The Performing Arts Parking Deck is 1½ blocks on the right.

If you need to leave the parking deck during the time the roads are closed, turn left onto South St. and right onto Salisbury St. and right onto Martin Luther King Blvd. After the next light bear right and circle around onto Dawson St. back to I-40. Once the roads are open and the traffic has cleared out, feel free to travel in and out as you please.

Another parking deck that is not marked on this map, but might be a little more convenient to get in is at the corner of Wilmington St. and Cabarrus St. Just continue to the 2<sup>nd</sup> light on Wilmington St. (after you pass the light at South St. and Wilmington St.) and turn right onto Cabarrus St. The parking deck entrance is on the left. You will need to walk two (2) blocks west to get to the Raleigh Convention Center.

The traffic is going to be very thick before, during and after the parade so we suggest that you start out early, enjoy the WRAL Christmas Parade, all the food and all the other wonderful things the Capital City has to offer, such as:
