Welcome to the 2017 fall sports season! As you prepare for your first official contest, there are a few things that I would like to share with you.

• State Meet

- o Saturday, November 4, 2017 at Ivey M. Redmon Sports Complex in Kernersville, NC
- o State Meet Director: Paul Egleston, Northwest Guilford High School
- o Race times can be found on the Cross Country page.
- The top twenty-five percent (25%) of teams in each classification from each regional will qualify to the state meet. (i.e. 23 teams entered for regional competition x .25 = 6 teams advancing to states) *Note:* A school must enter at least five athletes to be considered a team for regional competition.

• Regional Meets

- o Saturday, October 28, 2017
- o Use NC MileSplit (http://nc.milesplit.com) to enter teams into the regionals.
- Each school is allowed to enter up to seven (7) individuals for regional competition. **Please** have a copy of your registration confirmation at the Regional Meet.
- o Entries are due no later than 3:00pm on Friday, October 20, 2017.
- Late entries may be submitted to the NCHSAA, using the form posted on the website, no later than 3:00pm on Monday, October 23rd. A \$50 fee will be assessed for each individual entry.
- o Regional hosts and directors are posted on the Cross Country page.
 - Regions missing a host site and director: 1A Mideast, 1A West, 2A East, 2A West
 - If you are planning to host or would like to host, please contact me as soon as possible.

• Rules Reminders

- All regular season and conference meets must be completed before the regional entry deadline. Schools are not allowed to participate in meets after the entry deadline (Oct. 20th).
- o The NFHS 2017 Track & Field and Cross Country Rules Book is applicable this fall.
- o GPS devices are not permitted. Watches with GPS function are also prohibited.
- Uniform Reminders:
 - Any visible garment(s) worn by two or more team members underneath the uniform top shall be unadorned and of the same single, solid color, but not necessarily the same length.
 - Any visible garment(s) worn by two or more team members underneath the uniform bottom, extending below the knees, shall be unadorned and of the same single, solid color, but not necessarily the same length.
 - As per NFHS rules, a single, visible manufacturer's logo and/or single school name or insignia no more than 2 ¼ inches are permitted on the undergarment.
