6. Volleyball: Weekly and  
Tournament Limitation  
Change

During the regular season

- Allow any volleyball team to play in a maximum of two (2) tournaments (no maximum number of sets) that will not count towards the season limitation, seeding record, or MaxPreps ranking
- Additional weekly limitation language
  - 0 – 2 Regular Season Matches + 1 Tournament
  - 3 – 4 Regular Season Matches (no tournaments allowed)

**Rationale:** Tournaments are conducted with varying formats which lead to confusion among member schools. This proposal would help alleviate any confusion and mistakes regarding set/match limitations in tournament play.

## RECOMMENDATION

- The NC Wrestling Coaches Association, NC Chapter of USA Wrestling, and the NCHSAA would partner to facilitate
- NCUSA would serve as the "host" for the Invitational on Saturday, February 2<sup>nd</sup> at the Winston-Salem Fairgrounds Annex and Education Complex
- NCUSA would be responsible for facility rental, tournament equipment, volunteers, and securing officials
- NCHSAA would provide awards for the event.
- Use all NFHS wrestling rules and guidelines

**Rationale:** To provide a championship experience for the female wrestlers in North Carolina Help showcase the growing sport of women's wrestling. Wrestlers who compete in the tournament would remain eligible for the individual regional and state wrestling tournaments in the subsequent weeks.
