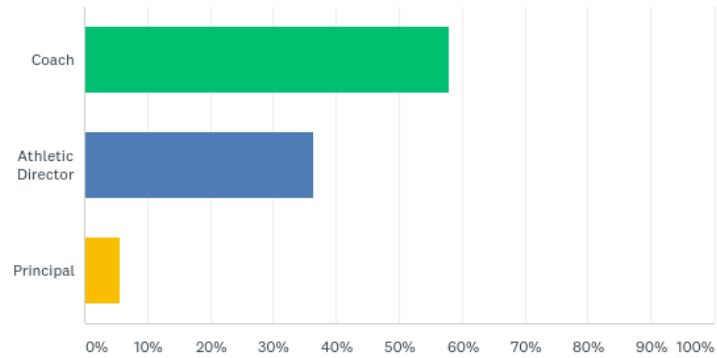

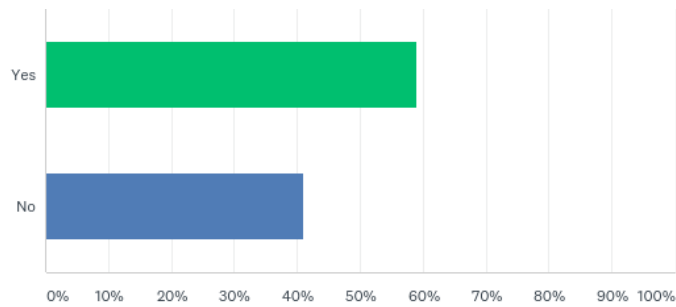

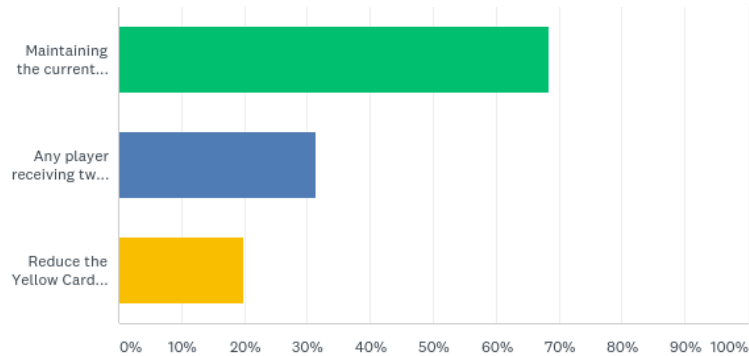

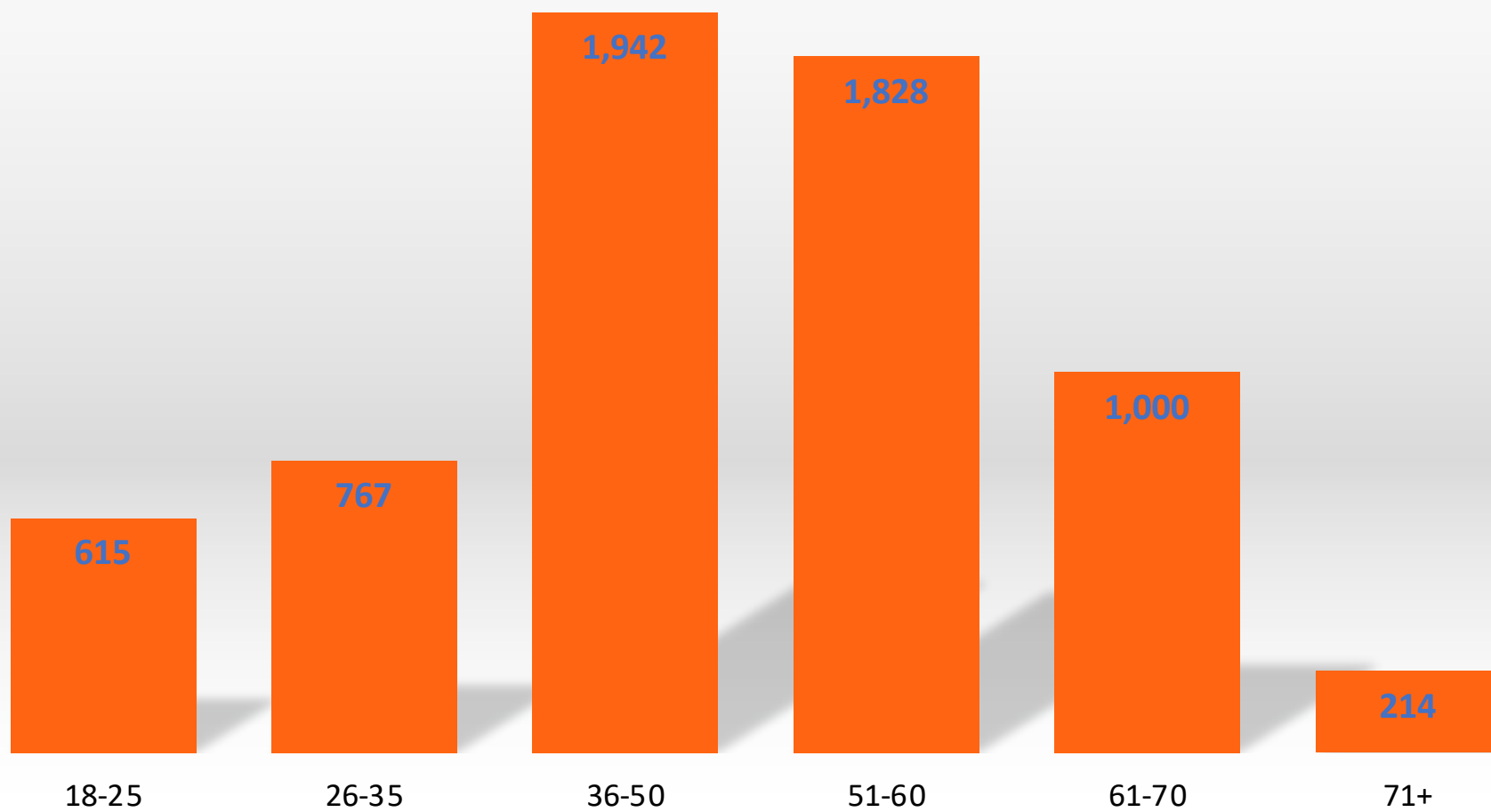

Maintaining the current system Coaches/Athletic Directors responsible for tracking Yellow Cards accumulated by their players. Five (5) Yellow Cards accumulated by the same player will result in a suspension (miss the next contest) - Yellow Cards are reset to zero once Playoffs begin - Three (3) Yellow Cards in the Playoffs, a player is suspended for the next contest.	68.37% 322
Any player receiving two (2) Yellow Cards in a game must miss the remainder of that contest and be suspended for next game.	31.42% 148
Reduce the Yellow Card accumulation total for a season to four (4). A player will automatically reduce his/her yellow card accumulation total by one Yellow Card each time he/she appears in four (4) consecutive matches without receiving a Yellow Card, Red Card or supplemental discipline in such matches. A player cannot have a negative yellow card accumulation total (cannot go below zero). The "Good Behavior" Incentive can only reset to a zero-card total. This incentive will be automatically applied a maximum of three (3) times throughout the course of the Regular Season.	19.96% 94
