



2020 - 2021 Men's & Women's Tennis Individual Tournament Team Championship Format

In March 2021, the NCHSAA Board of Directors voted unanimously to approve the designation of a team champion for each regional and state championship tournament. These state individual tournament team championship designations are in addition to the individual singles and doubles state champions. These champions will be awarded starting in the spring of 2021.

Detailed below is the team point structure for the regional and state championship events. Points will reset after the regional tournaments.

Regional Tournament Format:

16 Singles Players (Top 4 qualify for the state tournament) 16 Doubles Teams (Top 4 qualify for the state tournament)

1st Round Victory = 1 Point 2nd Round Victory = 2 Points Semifinals Victory = 3 Points

No additional points will be awarded for the 3rd/4th place match

Regional Champion = 4 Points

State Tournament Format:

16 Singles Players
16 Doubles Teams

1st Round Victory = 1 Point 2nd Round Victory = 2 Points Semifinals Victory = 3 Points State Champion = 4 Points

Additional Information:

- Singles and doubles points will count equally and will be totaled together to get the team scores
- If a player advances via default/bye, they will still get the points for that particular round
- Per NCHSAA Handbook policy 4.1.10, "a team must have multiple entries in the event to achieve a team championship. An individual may not earn a team title."
- If two (2) schools are tied for the most points earned in the regional or state championship, cochampions will be awarded
