RECOMMENDATION	SUPPORTING INFORMATION
To add an additional dead period from June 28, 2021, through July 3, 2021.	Rationale: Work-life conflict (burnout) was a common theme that resonated from Licensed Athletic Trainers (LAT) during the March 16 SMAC meeting. Multiple causes were identified; however, long hours due to an overlap of sports seasons and the additional daily duties imposed by COVID topped the list. Effects of burnout in LATs and First Responders (FR) included physical, emotional, and behavioral concerns (e.g., intention to leave the job or profession). The additional dead period will afford an additional opportunity for LATs and FRs to restore much-needed balance to their work-life obligations. Recommendation/Proposal: The NCHSAA to fully govern Cheerleading.

Rationale:

1. The NCHSAA already governs Cheerleading in the aspects of eligibility, coaching certifications, mandatory coaches rules meeting, AACCA certifications, and also holds an Invitational state competition.
2. Cheer should have a specific tryout date for the whole state to follow like all other sports. Specific dates for tryouts for both football cheer and basketball cheer. Recommend Aug. 1 for Fall and first day of winter sport tryouts for basketball cheer.
3. Cheer should follow skill development guidelines like all other sports.
4. Conducting tryouts in May or June is not fair to students who move in over summer and find out that the team has already been chosen. Schools could still give these summer enrollees a separate tryout but not really fair to all the other girls that did not make the team for the new enrollee to get a private tryout. Setting a tryout date in August would eliminate most of this issue.
5. Cheer teams can still go to camp during the summer. They may have to take more girls than they normally would since team would not be picked yet, but aren't we supposed to be about providing opportunities to students and "open to all, required of none"? No other teams get to pick their teams before Aug. 1st.
6. Consistency across the state.
