- 1964: Merriam won two-man playoff over Leonard Thompson with par on first playoff hole
- 1966: Reidsville defeated Fayetteville on first hole of playoff
- 1973: Hoch won two-man playoff over Chip Beck with birdie on first playoff hole
- 1977: Stiles won two-man playoff over Mike West with par on second playoff hole
- 1986: 3A/4A--Secore won three-man playoff over Chris Greenwood (East Burke) and Mike Bell (North Forsyth) with par on first playoff hole; Greenwood took second on second playoff hole
1A/2A--declared individual co-champions
- 1987: 4A--Jacksonville defeated Triton on second hole of sudden death playoff to win team championship
- 1988: 1A/2A--Peavy won two-man playoff over Joel White (Ahoskie) with birdie on first playoff hole
- 1990: 1A/2A--James Kenan defeated Monroe on second hole of sudden death playoff for second place
3A--Gary Ashburn (Southwest Guilford) took second place in four-man playoff over Ben Edwards (D. H. Conley), Clark Fargis (Reidsville) and Ryan Broadwell (Kings Mountain) with par on second playoff hole; Edwards took third with par on fourth playoff hole
- 1991: 3A--Alex Hooper (Reidsville) won two-man playoff over David Mathis (North Davidson) with par on second hole to win medalist honors

2007: 4-A: Adam Stephenson (Rose) won two-man playoff over Nik Peterson (Providence) with birdie on first playoff hole; 3-A: Harold Varner (Forestview) won two-man playoff over Drew Page (Tuscola) on third playoff hole; Hickory took team title based on fifth player's score over two days; 1-A: with three-way tie for first, John Weldon (East Surry) won three-man playoff over Tommy Gibson (East Surry) and Justin Goforth (West Montgomery) on first playoff hole; Weldon had birdie, Gibson par and Goforth a bogey.

2008: 3-A: Harold Varner (Gastonia Forestview) won two-man playoff over Daniel Claytor (Northern Nash) with par on second playoff hole for second place; 1-A: Andrew Bateman (Andrews) won two-man playoff over David Kostval (Topsail) with birdie on third playoff hole for second place; Joe Ondish (Topsail) won two-man playoff over Ethan Grimmer (East Surry) with birdie on second playoff hole for fourth place.

2012: 4-A: Michael Klasing (Ardrey Kell) won playoff with Harrison Rhoades (Broughton) with birdie on first playoff hole for third place; 3-A: Will Long (Forestview) won playoff with Brandon Katsoudas (Marvin Ridge) with par on second playoff hole for second place; 2-A: Taylor Coalson (North Surry) won playoff with Alex Nianouris (Salisbury) on second playoff hole for medalist.

2013: 4-A: Pinecrest defeated Myers Park on first playoff hole for first place in team standings; Trey Guy (Terry Sanford) won playoff with Stephen Saleeby (Raleigh Broughton) with birdie on first playoff hole for second place; Phillip Oweida (Myers Park) won playoff with Seth Gandy (Hough) with eagle on first playoff hole for fourth place. 1-A: Blake Fiest (Lake Norman Charter) defeated Jonathon Davis (Bishop McGuinness) with birdie on second playoff hole for fourth place.

2014: 1-A: Jordan Vogler (East Surry) defeated Logan Wynne (Riverside Martin) with birdie on first playoff hole for third place. 2-A: Elliott Grayson (Sheby) took third, Stephen Abrams (Beddingfield) fourth and Justin Emmons (Providence Grove) 5th in playoff; 4-A: Patrick Cover (Hough) won playoff for first with Stephen Franken (Millbrook) with birdie on first playoff hole; Josh Martin (Pinecrest) won playoff for fourth with Preyer Fountain (Broughton) and Stephen Saleeby (Broughton) with birdie on first playoff hole.

2015: 2-A: Wilkes Central defeated South Stokes on first hole of playoff for second place. 1-A: Nick Gunnell (Starmount) won five-way playoff for fourth place.

2016: 2A: Justin Emmons from Providence Grove used a bogey-free 4-under par 68 on day two to force a playoff with day one leader Logan McNeely from Newton-Conover who recorded a 3-over 75 on day two. Emmons won the playoff on the first hole with a par.

2018: 4A: A.J. Beechler from Pinecrest shot 70 in the final round to force a playoff with Broughton's Peter Fountain. Beechler won the playoff with a par on the first playoff hole, the 18th at Pinehurst No. 6 completing back-to-back titles.

2021: 1A: Community School of Davidson defeated East Surry by two shots in a one-hole team playoff on the par 4 1st hole at Foxfire's Red Fox Course. CSD shot 15 on the 365 yard hole while East Surry's best four carded 17.
