2021 NCHSAA VOLLEYBALL PLAYOFF **CHAMPIONSHIP NOTES**

The default match time is 7:00 p.m. By mutual agreement, a match time of 6:00 p.m. is permissible without NCHSAA approval. Any match time earlier than 6:00 p.m. must be approved by the NCHSAA. For matches scheduled for Saturday, any mutually agreed upon match time does not require NCHSAA approval. However, on Saturdays, if teams cannot mutually agree, the higher seeded team may choose a starting time between 1:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. Should the visiting team have to travel more than 100 miles one way for the contest, the start time must be chosen between 1:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. The NCHSAA does permit schools to play earlier than the day listed for a given round, provided there is mutual agreement.

Dowler joins Cardinal Gibbons' Madison Bugg and Hendersonville's Bailey Hunter as three-time winners.


