| Recommend that entire teams no longer receive team exclusions from postseason competition due to individual ejections If a team has players and/or coaches that accumulate six or more individual ejections, only the players/coaches ejected six or more times will be ineligible for the playoffs If a team receives more than 3 ejections during one incident, only the players ultimately eligible for ejection will be ineligible for the playoffs In the event a physical altercation on the field/court occurs involving more players than are immediately identified by the officials, the NCHSAA may identify a total number of participants through video review that are eligible for ejection and require that the school identify individual players to receive the ejection(s) Subsequent ejections for individual players and/or coaches (loss of eligibility in following games) could result in the team's inability to compete in subsequent games due to the total number of eligible players remaining.
