# 2022 NCHSAA WOMEN'S SOCCER PLAYOFF NOTES



CHAPEL HILL - The North Carolina High School Athletic Association (NCHSAA) finalized and released the playoff brackets for the 2022 Women's Soccer Championships. The tournament has four classifications of play with six playoff rounds each. The State Championship Games will be contested on Friday, June 3 and Saturday, June 4 at Koka Booth Stadium at WakeMed Soccer Park in Cary. Tickets to the Championships can be purchased in advance through the NCHSAA's partnership with GoFan.

The 2022 NCHSAA Women's Soccer Championships will be broadcast live by the NFHS Network. Network subscribers can watch NCHSAA Championships live and on-demand as well as playoff and championship action from other state associations across the country. Subscriptions are just \$10.95 for a month. Media outlets seeking to broadcast an NCHSAA Playoff game live must submit the online Broadcast Post-Season Request Form by visiting the Media section of the NCHSAA's website. All forms must be completed at least 24-hours prior to the start of the contest.

All media seeking to cover the State Championships must submit a single-event credential request through the Credentials page of the NCHSAA Website by Thursday, June 2 at noon.

The Spartans netted three goals in each half, continuing to pour on the pressure against a Franklin Academy side that only was able to muster four shots toward goal.

Michaela Deas was selected as the game's Most Valuable Player, netting three goals and adding an assist on a goal to Tyler Baughn in the latter stages of the first half to put the Spartans comfortably ahead 3-0 at the break. Deas opened the scoring in the 6' with an unassisted goal, showing remarkable skill dribbling through defenders to the edge of the box where she beat the keeper with a well-placed right-footed shot.

Deas grabbed her second in the 14' with a right-footed volley shot to the back of the net off a beautiful cross by sophomore Cameron Koster from the right side near the goal line. Deas also scored in the second half, closing out the scoring in the 53' when Eleanor Nguyen played her through on the left side. Deas took the feed, switched to her right foot and slipped it past the keeper to go up 6-0.

Baughn had an outstanding game for the Spartans as well, netting a pair of goals in the game. Charley Teckenbrock also played well for CSD netting the Spartans fifth goal of the day in the 49' and assisting Baughn on the fourth of the match with a beautiful through ball that left Baughn one-on-one with the Patriots keeper.



### 2A Championship: Lake Norman Charter blasts Carrboro 5-0

GREENSBORO, NC – Lake Norman Charter was dominant from start to finish in a 5-0 win over Carrboro in the 2021 2A Women's Soccer State Championship Match at Jamieson Stadium on the campus of Grimsley High School. The Knights netted four first-half goals on the way to the school's second State Championship in Women's Soccer.

Asha Means was purely spectacular, taking on defenders and working as a force in the attacking end. She finished the game with a hat trick of three goals as she was selected as the 2A State Championship Game Most Valuable Player.

Eliza Rich also had a fabulous game for the Knights, breaking the ice early with a goal on an assist from Kayla Patel in the 2'. Rich later found the back of the net in the 16' on a feed by Kaela Rasenberger, blasting the ball home with her right foot from 30 yards out to go up 3-0.

Means netted the first of her three markers on a header from a cross sent in by Haven Stanley out of the deep left corner in the 8', putting Lake Norman Charter up 2-0. Means added a pair of unassisted goals later, scoring one in the 18' and the other in 49', both on near breakaway-type opportunities.







### 3A Championship: Cox Mill dominates possession on way to 1-0 win over Chapel Hill

GREENSBORO, NC – The Cox Mill Chargers dominated possession and managed to sneak one goal through to defeat Chapel Hill 1-0 in the 3A Women's Soccer State Championship at Jamieson Stadium on the campus of Grimsley High School. The Chargers collected the school's first Women's Soccer State Championship with the victory.

Cox Mill was on the front foot early, pinning their ears back to press and attack high up the field. Their early pressure paid off when Julianne Patterson slotted a perfect pass through the Tiger defense to the feet of Emily Mooney just outside the penalty area. Mooney took a few dribbles and unleashed a rocket past the keeper off her right foot to put the Chargers in front in the 7'.

The story of the game was Cox Mill's defensive back four. They seemed an impenetrable wall, limiting the Tigers to just four shots in the game. The best chance for Chapel Hill came in the closing minutes of the contest when Sofia Canoutas-Nadel found herself with time and space about 35 yards from goal and unleashed a rocket that Jillian Ginn had to handle. Otherwise, the Tigers only managed four total shots and one other shot on goal.

The Chargers' dominant defensive performance could be attributed to a total team effort, but senior Jesse Dunn was outstanding at left center back. She regularly thwarted Chapel Hill challenges, shutting down most any activity on the right side of the Chapel Hill attack. She also made a strong run off a steal, sprinting about 60 yards in possession before finding Emily Bertanzeti in the box with about 12 minutes to play. Bertanzeti was not able to put the shot on target, but Dunn's dangerous run demonstrated her total play-making ability and helped her win a selection as the game's Most Valuable Player.




### 4A Championship: Myers Park knocks off Pinecrest 2-0 for first title

GREENSBORO, NC – The Myers Park Mustangs got a pair of goals from a pair of seniors, lifting them to their first State Championship in the Women's Soccer program's history. Caileen Almeida struck the decisive blow in the 70' on a free kick from roughly 35 yards out to put the Mustangs up 2-0 and effectively end any hope of a Pinecrest come back in the 4A Women's Soccer Championship at Grimsley High School's Jamieson Stadium.

Almeida blasted a rising shot over the Patriots four-person wall, and the ball began its descent into the back of the net just as it was crossing over the head of the Pinecrest keeper at the edge of the six-yard box. The Mustangs celebrated and were able to comfortably bleed out the remaining ten minutes to win a championship three years removed from heart-breaking defeat in the 2018 State Championship.

Almeida also was critical in the midfield defense and offensive build-up for the Mustangs, checking the most trouble-some Patriot, Lauren Landry, through the midfield for the majority of the second half. Almeida was selected as the game's Most Valuable Player for her efforts.

The Mustangs got on the board in the first half when the Patriots had a misplayed ball in the box that fell to Caroline Pulliam. Pulliam made no mistaking pushing the ball into the right side of the netting in the 18' to give the Mustangs a 1-0 lead.











### 1A Championship: Union Academy gets golden goal to knock out Franklin Academy in OT

RALEIGH, NC - In a defensively-minded 1A State Championship, it was the Cardinals of Union Academy that prevailed in the second "Golden Goal" overtime 2-1 over Franklin Academy to win the school's second Women's Soccer State Championship in two years. The Cardinals winning goal came from Junior Midfielder Sarah Brown who sprinted upfield with under a minute to play to join the decisive attack in the final overtime period. Brown's game-winning boot earned her the game's Most Valuable Player.

The first 15 minutes of play remained scoreless until Kelsey Havican of Union Academy scored on a beautiful assist from Rebecca Garcia at the 19th minute of the match to put the Cardinals up 1-0. Franklin Academy had several opportunities to tie the game in the first half with five shots, in comparison to the Cardinals' six shots.

Union Academy stood firm on defense throughout the second before Franklin Academy's Ashlynn Stephan ripped in a goal from the corner of the box at the 58th-minute mark to even the score at one. The Patriots and Cardinals both remained strong on defense for the remainder of the second half, forcing overtime where both teams failed to net goals until the decisive blow by Brown.

Franklin Academy finished the season 22-1 and 14-0 in the North Central 1A Conference. The Patriots made the school's third appearance in an NCHSAA Women's Soccer State Championship Game. Union Academy wrapped up the year 22-0, while they were 12-0 and champions of the Pac 7 1A Conference. The Cardinals made the school's second appearance in an NCHSAA Women's Soccer State Championship Game, winning back-to-back titles.



### 2A Championship: Carrboro outlasts Lake Norman Charter in PK's to win fifth title

RALEIGH, NC - The 2A Women's Soccer State Championship was an excellent defensive display, but it was the Jaguars of Carrboro that prevailed in the penalty kick shootout, 4-3 over Lake Norman Charter to win the schools fifth Women's Soccer State Championship. It was their fourth in five years.

Carrboro's winning goal occurred during the seventh round of the penalty kick shootout. Lake Norman Charter's Ally Smith was stopped on her attempt, while Carrboro's Olivia Winker drilled her attempt to win the 2019 State Championship Title. MVP Navia Mosley played an outstanding game, while also netting a much-needed penalty kick during round 4.

The first goal of the match occurred quickly, as MVP Mosley of Carrboro knocked it home off a corner sent in by Brynn Holt-Ling at the five-minute mark. The Jaguars lead did not last long with Ayden Yates of Lake Norman Charter finding the back of the net at the 15th minute to tie the game at 1-1. The remainder of the half was evenly played with both teams tightening up on the defensive side of the ball.

The Jaguars and Knights both had ample opportunities offensively during the front end of the second half. The match saw an impactful change once a player from Lake Norman Charter received their second yellow card of the day, resulting in the Knights playing with ten players for the remainder of the game. Both teams displayed strong defensive stands, thwarting many numerous offensive attacks, resulting in overtime.

Carrboro had the first scoring opportunity of overtime as Brynn Holt-Ling fired one in for the Jaguars, but goalkeeper Kaela Rasenberger of Lake Norman Charter skillfully stopped her attempt. The Jaguars and Knights played scoreless through the two overtime periods. Although the overtime periods were uneventful, Lake Norman Charter received a red card for unsportsmanlike conduct in the last minutes of the second overtime, resulting in the Knights playing with nine players for the remainder of the game.

Lake Norman Charter wrapped up the year 22-1, while they were 12-0 and champions of the South Fork 2A Conference. The Knights made the school's second appearance in an NCHSAA Women's Soccer State Championship Game. Carrboro finished the season 18-1-2 and 10-0 in the Mid-State 2A Conference. The Jaguars made the school's fifth appearance in an NCHSAA Women's Soccer State Championship Game.







### 3A Championship: East Chapel Hill blasts by T.C. Roberson 2-0 to win fourth title

RALEIGH, NC - East Chapel Hill won their first state championship since 2004, as they downed T.C Roberson 2-0, after two first-half goals from the game's Most Valuable Player, Sophia Coon.

East Chapel Hill had their way in the first half scoring quickly to open the game as Sophia Coon of the Wildcats drilled one in off an assist by Kate Sheslow in the 2ndminute. The Wildcats would find the back of the net again at the 17thminute, with Sophia Coon scoring once more by sending one off the bar and in. Goalkeeper Tierney McConnel of East Chapel Hill, along with the Wildcats defense, played a spectacular first half, preserving their lead 2-0 at the half.

The Wildcats had not conceded a goal all postseason and that defensive dominance continued for East Chapel Hill throughout the State Championship. T.C Robinson had numerous attempts on the offensive side of the field but could not get past the Wildcats defensive line and goalkeeper McConnel. East Chapel Hill completed its shutout postseason against the Rams, resulting in the Wildcats fourth state title in program history.

T.C Robinson wrapped up the year 23-5, while they were 15-1 in the Western Mountain 3A Conference. The Rams made the school's seventh appearance in an NCHSAA Women's Soccer State Championship Game. East Chapel Hill finished the season 20-2-2 and 13-1 in the Big 8 3A Conference. The Wildcats made the school's fourth appearance in an NCHSAA Women's Soccer State Championship Game.



### 4A Championship: Heritage nips Pinecrest in penalty kicks to earn first State Championship

RALEIGH, NC - After a strong defensive performance by both teams in regulation and overtime, the Heritage Huskies won the school's first Women's Soccer State Championship in a penalty kick shootout over Pinecrest 1-1 (4-2 PK). Defenseman Braelyn Francher of Heritage was awarded the game's Most Valuable Player after breaking up the momentum on several attacks by the Patriots throughout the game and scoring one of the four successful attempts for Heritage during the penalty kick shootout.

Heritage dominated possession in the first half, but the Huskies failed to get a goal past the Patriots' back line and goalkeeper Carley Modlin. Pinecrest was unable to get the ball past midfield for most of the first half, due to strong pressure from the Huskies.

The Huskies pushed forward in the 53rd minute with Raegan Meyer burying a chance in the box, to put Heritage up 1-0 with 27 minutes remaining in the game. Pinecrest's Madi Pry responded with a beautiful free kick goal right outside the far left of the box in the 56th minute to tie the match 1-1. Both teams had several opportunities on goal during the second half but were unable to capitalize in regulation.

In the first round of penalty kicks, Jessica Cannon of the Huskies missed off the post, while Keeley Copper of the Patriots squeaked her goal into the bottom right corner. Fain Buete and Hayley Boyles of Heritage both drilled their attempts in the second and third round. Pinecrest's Madi Pry and Lauren Landry missed the mark on each of their attempts. In the fourth round of penalty kicks, both Braelyn Francher of Heritage and Parker Mecimore of Pinecrest put the ball past the goalies for a score. Finally, Bri Holt of the Huskies ended the game, scoring with a shot to the back left of the net that lifted the Huskies to a 4-2 victory in penalty kicks.

Pinecrest finished the season 26-1-1 and 14-0 in the Sandhills 4A Conference. The Patriots made the school's first appearance in an NCHSAA Women's Soccer State Championship Game. Heritage wrapped up the year 20-3, while they were 9-1 and champions of the Northern 4A Conference. The Huskies also made their school's first appearance in an NCHSAA Women's Soccer State Championship Game.
