

NCHSAA 3A CENTRAL REGIONAL Guidelines and Information

Coaches: Please report to the check in table located outside the proshop upon arrival to receive your information packets. Bring your own lanyard for your coach's badge.

Tees/Yardage: We will play from the Red Tees and will use a NCHSAA 3A Central Regional Tee Marker for the Day of the Event. We are set up to play 5034 yards.

Check In Tables: There will be a check in table under the canopy on hole #1 where each player will receive their local rules and pin sheet for the day. Players should report to the check in table 10 minutes prior to their tee time.

Coaches Meeting: This meeting is mandatory by the NCHSAA and will be in the Club House. Coaches Meeting will be after the last group tees off (11:30am).

Carts: Spectator carts will be available on the day of the regionals for \$25 for Spectator Carts. First Come First Serve (Pull Carts for players are allowed per NCHSAA guidelines).

Coaches Carts will be held for each Coach and Coaches Carts are FREE.

Range: On Monday October 17, the range will be open at 7:30 AM. Range Fee is \$4 per token.

Dress Code: Proper golf attire is required by all coaches, and players.

Guidelines continued....

All spectators' carts will be restricted to **cart paths only**. Players will not be allowed to ride in carts at any point during the tournament.

1. Spectators (may leave the cart paths via foot to assist in finding lost balls. It is recommended that spectators/coaches fore caddy from the cart path by being 100-150 in advance of the player hitting to help spot balls. This will reduce lost balls and improve pace of play.
2. **Hole #1** If a shot enters the red stakes area (that is NOT a tee shot), there is an additional relief option (drop zone) just beyond the bridge on the right. If the tee shot goes into the water, the player may NOT use this drop zone option. The drop zone is only for shots beyond the tee shot and players will still encounter 1 stroke penalty.
3. **Hole #14** If a tee shot enters the water, the player does have an additional penalty option (drop zone) located on the other side of the water. Penalty stroke still applies. Players can also elect the normal red stake options if they do not want the drop zone.
4. If balls are hit into the tree lines or woods that are NOT marked with red stakes, the player needs to hit a provisional in case the ball cannot be found. Lost balls must be hit from the previous location with a penalty stroke added.

Restrooms are available in the clubhouse. There is also a set of restrooms between #9 and #10 (also near 18th tee) and a port of jon near the tee box on #5.

The Club House Will be Open for business. Hotdogs, Sandwiches, Chips, Candy bars/Snacks, and a variety of drinks will be available for purchase throughout the day.
