Regional Play Information - Monday May 8, 2023

Start Time: Tee times will be begin at 9:00 AM using both #1 and #10 tee

Coaches Check-in: Please report to check-in table upon arrival - There will be a check in table under a tent where each player will receive their local rules and info for the day.

Tees/Yardage: Green Tees will be used; approximately 6,394 yards.

Pin/Tee Sheets: The course do not have specific pin sheets - They will have colored coded flags:

- Red = front pin
- White = middle pin
- Blue back = back pin

Carts: One cart per team/coach will be provided at no cost. Spectator carts can be purchased but are limited. Spectator carts are \$25. *The course is not easy to walk.*

Range: Driving Range will be available with complimentary balls at the day of the regional tournament

Food: Host schools will provide breakfast for coaches the morning of the regional. The golf course has a small grill for premade sandwiches and hotdogs that will be open the day of the tournament for lunches.

Parking: There should be ample parking, small school busses can park along the main road in the grass to allow for automobiles to utilize the spaces.
