Points of Emphasis: In 2022-23, a total of \$1,188,330.87 was distributed to member schools/students/coaches/athletic administrators from General Endowment Fund, Scholarship & Awards Fund, and Education/Health & Safety Endowment Fund for education-based grants, scholarships & awards, year-end distributions to schools and Level 1-3 school and CAA/CMAA reimbursements. Over past 13 years (2010-11 through 2022-2023), a total of \$13,838,274.00 has been distributed to member high schools from Endowment earnings and Board Designated endowed funds.	***Discussion Only***	
In September 2024, the NCHSAA is slated to host the annual Section III Meeting (hosting duties are rotated between the 8 Section III states). Staff recommends that undesignated and/or unexpected corporate support funds in the current fiscal year be used in part to offset Section 3 Meeting expenses.
