Friday Packet Pick-up: At the finish line (**Green tent**)

Saturday Pick-up:

- **Team Qualifiers:** Will be picked up on the right side of the baseball scoring tower. There will be a **Green** Tent set up. *This will be the same location where teams are dropped off and where the buses will park.*
- **Packets must be picked up by head coach**
- **Individual Qualifiers:** Will be picked up at the NCHSAA tent near the spectator entrance gate. **(There will be signage)**

Team Entrance:

- If your school has at least **ONE TEAM** competing, you will use the **Back Gate Entrance Near the Baseball Fields**
- If your school has **ONLY INDIVIDUAL** competitors, you will use the **Tent on the Left Side of Beeson Road**
- **Teams will enter through the gate beside concession stands at baseball fields**

Parking:

- **Buses**

Will be directed to park in the designated parking lot. Buses will not need a pass to park in the designated lot.

Please do not drop off your runners anywhere before you get to the the bus parking area
Please make sure that all team items are on the bus and not in the cars

- **Spectator Parking:**

- Spectators will park in the lot across the road from the park entrance
- Handicap parking will be in the gravel lot near the start/finish area. Handicap placards must be visible

- **Coaches that drive their own cars:**
 - If a coach drives their own vehicle, they will need to park in the spectator parking which is the lot across the road from the park entrance even if they have an athlete or athletes with them
 - Coaches park free with their coaches' card. **However, your coaches' card does not give you access to VIP parking.**

- **Course Inspection:**
 - The Town Manager of Kernersville has granted permission for state-qualifying teams and individuals to inspect the cross-country course at Ivey M. Redmon Sports Complex on Friday, November 1st
 - The inspection of the course on Friday will begin at 2:30 P.M. and conclude at 6:00 P.M.
 - *The park will close at 6:00 P.M. that day; therefore, the grounds must be cleared of all people by 6:00 P.M.*
 - On Saturday, November 2, 2024, the course will be available for inspection from:
7:00 A.M. – 8:45 A.M.
12:00 P.M. – 1:45 P.M.
 - *The course must be cleared for the next race fifteen minutes prior to the scheduled start of the race*
 - Public address announcements will be made regarding course inspection times. Failure to abide by inspection regulations could result in the disqualification of contestants/teams

- **Team Camp:**
 - Team tents and the team camp area will be set up in the two outfields of the baseball fields. Teams can select which outfield they would like to set up in.
 - Team will utilize Fields 2 and 3
 - **PLEASE STAY OFF THE INFIELD DIRT ON THE BASEBALL FIELD**
 - Team camps are NOT permitted inside the spectator area of Ivey M. Redmon Sports Complex
 - **Please remember to stake down all tents!!**
 - **Tents can be set up Friday**

- **Competitor Numbers:**
 - Your runners have been assigned a competitor bib number with a timing chip. Please place the bib on the front of the uniform. Please do not overhandle the bibs and DO NOT let runners switch bibs

- **Reporting for the Race:**
 - Runners need to be at the starting line 15 minutes before their race starts

- **Blocking is not allowed and will result in disqualification:**
 - Runners must not impede another runner who is attempting to pass

- **Parents and Spectators:**
 - Must stay off the course during the race. The course is well-marked and roped off in all areas. There is to be no interference in the cross-over area.

- **GPS Functions:**
 - Using GPS function will be grounds for disqualification

- **Uniform Rules:**
 - Make sure that all athletes are in uniform and equipment compliance

- **Prohibited Items:**

- Pets and recreation equipment
- Frisbees, footballs, baseballs, softballs, concealed weapons, pets, and dogs except for certified service dogs
- Drones
- In addition, no fences are to be climbed at Beeson Park
- Individuals who violate this regulation will be requested to leave with no refund of the admission fee.
