Play is governed by the USGA Rules of Golf, the following Local Rules, and NCHSAA Terms of the Competition.

PLAY THE BALL DOWN

TEES

All players will use NCHSAA tees.

Format

36-hole of Individual stroke play.

Caddies

No Caddies.

OUT OF BOUNDS

LOCAL RULE IS NOT IN EFFECT-must play from previous spot

Out of bounds is defined by:

- the course side of white stakes at ground level with or without red tops and white stakes with green tops
- white lines adjacent to white stakes
- fences around the perimeter of the course.
- left side of cart path between the two white stakes with green tops to the left of #9 green.
- horse track posts on the golf course are immovable obstructions and do not define out of bounds.

SAND AREAS

All sand areas are played as part of the general area. There are no bunkers. Players are encouraged to rake or smooth sand after playing their shot.

SHORT COURSE

Short course (defined by white stakes) right of #13, #15 and #16 is out of bounds.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR

Un-marked tire ruts may be played as ground under repair.

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS

Horse track fences and poles on the golf course may be played as immovable obstructions.

Cart control timbers adjacent to cart paths may be played as part of the obstruction.

All sand cart paths are natural surfaces and not immovable obstructions.

Landscaped areas surrounded by a paved cart path may be played as part of the obstruction.

NO PLAY AREAS

All practice putting/chipping greens/practice bunkers are no play areas. Relief is mandatory and without penalty.

RULINGS

In case of a ruling, request a ruling/official in the iWanamaker app.
