Play is governed by the USGA Rules of Golf, the following Local Rules, and NCHSAA Terms of the Competition.

PLAY THE BALL DOWN

TEES

All play will be from the NCHSAA tee markers.

Format

36-hole of Individual stroke play.

CADDIES

No Caddies.

OUT OF BOUNDS

LOCAL RULE IS NOT IN EFFECT-must play from previous spot

Out of bounds is defined by the course side points of white stakes at ground level; by white lines tying into white stakes, split-rail fences and paved roads; by the maintenance building left of #10; by the split-rail fence behind #13 green; the fence left of #17; by the course side edge of paved roads and beyond even if the ball comes to rest on another part of the course; by the backside edge (clubhouse side) of the curb behind #9 and #18 greens and by the white stakes with green tops, tying into the curb. The cart path and curb are obstructions.

OBSTRUCTIONS

Split-rail fences, stone walls and railroad ties adjacent to cart paths and areas encircled by a cart path are deemed part of the obstruction.

Birdhouses and support posts are immovable obstructions.


Yardage posts in fairways are movable obstructions.

Stakes and ropes supporting trees are immovable obstructions.

The rocky cart path that crosses hole #10 is deemed to be an immovable obstruction.

Wrong Green 13.1F

If a player's ball comes to rest on a wrong green, the player must take complete relief to the nearest point of relief. The green stakes between the green on #9 and #18 defines the split putting green.
