Recommendation For: Gosnell White

For North Carolina High School Hall Of Fame.

I have known Gosnell Rusty White since he was in high school at West Charlotte Senior High and I a Junior High student at Quail Hollow. Gosnell was four grades ahead of me in school but we both attended University Park Elementary School prior to my family moving to another neighborhood. I was his jv coach and varsity assistant coach for 11 years at West Charlotte High School. Where I credit Gosnell for teaching me the game of basketball.

Gosnell was a standout basketball player under the Legendary Hall of Fame Basketball Coach Charles McCullough at West Charlotte where he also ran track which he won a scholarship for to Howard University in Washington DC.

After college, Gosnell followed both parents into an education career teaching Health/Pe at Ranson Middle School while also coaching Men's Basketball and Track and Field. He found success immediately both on the track and the basketball court. Earning several coaches awards and enjoying many winning seasons and championships in basketball on the middle school level. Gosnell was not only an outstanding coach and mentor to young men and women but his infectious personality, smile, and keen knowledge and understanding of sports, especially basketball made him a favorite teacher among all his students as well as other staff members.

Gosnell left middle school and went to Harding High School where he was on pace to win 100 games faster than any other coach in Mecklenburg County history. Gosnell accumulated a record of 74-29 at Harding where in 1995 He was Mecklenburg County coach of the Year.

Coach White returned to his alma mater West Charlotte and in his first three years took the Lions to two Regional Championship games and won the State Championship in 1999 in the third year. Coach White compiled a record of 83 and 10 in those three seasons. When he retired from West Charlotte in 2007 he had a career record of 456-174 with eight straight Conference Titles, from 1997-2004. His teams made five 3A or 4A Western Regional appearances. At

West Charlotte he was 382-89. He was Observer Regional Coach of the year in 1999 and 2005.

He went on after retiring in Mecklenburg County to coach seven more years in Union County and a new school at that time Marvin Ridge High School until 2014. Coach White has spent his career teaching and mentoring young men not just basketball but life skills for success beyond and after their playing days end.

Dear NCHSAA Hall of Fame Committee,

To whom it may concern. I am writing this letter of recommendation on behalf of my former Coach and mentor Coach Gosnell "Rusty" White to be nominated, considered and inducted into the next NCHSAA Hall of Fame for his contributions as a Varsity Basketball Head Coach for 22 years at the High School level. Coach White made a huge impact at three High Schools(1992-2014) after 15 years at Ranson Junior High School going 127-60 as a Varsity Basketball Head Coach giving him the opportunity to coach at the high school level. Coach White was also the Head Track Coach and Assistant Coach for Football at Ranson Jr. High School at the Varsity level.

Coach White first high school coaching job was at Harding University High School(1992-1996) formerly known as Harry Harding High School where he went 74-29 in four years winning two conference championships and finished with the highest winning percentage in Harding Boys basketball history.

Coach White then returned to his alma mater West Charlotte High School from 1996-2007 to help restore the Boys Basketball program two years after NCHSAA Hall of Famer Coach Charles Adams McCullough left in 1994 to coach at College Basketball. Coach White played basketball and ran track for Coach McCullough at West Charlotte. In his 11 seasons at West Charlotte he was 285-55 winning a State Championship in 1999 in dominating fashion, he also had 5 Western Regional appearances in his 11 seasons of coaching at West Charlotte. Coach White ended up retiring from CMS after 30 years of service as a PE Teacher, Basketball Coach, Mentor to Students and his Co-Workers and he was a strong Father figure to so many Students whether he coached them or not. He left West Charlotte as second

Coach White last stop was Marvin Ridge High School 2007-2014 which he helped open up the school and was the first Varsity Boys Head Coach in school history. He helped set the foundation for the basketball program and did so with a 94-64 record.

In conclusion Coach Gosnell "Rusty" White made an impact no matter what school he was at for 37 years. Coach White had a unique way of using his talent, sharp-mind, high sports IQ, discipline and work ethic which made him an All-American Track Student-Athlete at Howard University. He won with integrity and had a win percentage over 70 percent. He won 423 games at the High School level and won almost 550 games total in his career with only a few .500 seasons and 1-2 losing seasons in 37 years.

I personally have a unique viewpoint because I played for Coach White at Ranson Jr. High School(1988-1991I, he coached against me when he was Varsity Boys Basketball Head Coach at Harding and I was in High School at West Charlotte(1992-1994) and I later joined his coaching staff for 3 years(2002-2005) and was on his last coaching staff in his last Western Regional appearance in 2005 at West Charlotte. Coach White taught us discipline, work ethic,

how to win the right way and you knew you had to be in top shape to play for him. Hence the 6:30 mile you had to make to try out for the team established at Ranson Jr. High and continued to his last coaching season.

First, he brought Harding University "HS" from a place of despair to a place of prominence in only a few years, before moving on the West Charlotte High. Under the leadership of Coach White, West Charlotte won eight straight conference championships from 1997 to 2004, and made five western regional appearances, including capturing the 1999 NCHSAA 4-state championship. Coach White also took Marvin Ridge High School to two conference championships as well as two tournament championships.
