The 2025 Championships mark the seventh straight time that the Greensboro Coliseum Complex has hosted this event (2018 was the first year, no tournament in 2021 due to COVID-19).

Championship Appearances

Of the eight teams competing in the NCHSAA Dual Team Wrestling Championships, five of them competed for Dual Team titles in the past and three of them participated last season. Uwharrie Charter is back in the final for the sixth year in a row, and looking for their third championship in a row. They will face Mount Airy, which is making its Championship match debut.

Seaforth made its debut last year and has returned again in 2025, this year they will face the Hilltoppers from Rutherford-Spindale Central, which is making its debut. Union Pines secured its fourth consecutve Eastern Regional Championship this year and will aim for its first NCHSAA State Title on Saturday. Pisgah is making its third appearance but first since 2002.

In the 4A match, Cardinal Gibbons ended Laney's streak of three straight 4A Eastern Regional Championships as the Crusaders beat the Buccaneers 44-30 in the Regional Final. Cardinal Gibbons is making its second appearance in the Championship match. They will meet Hickory Ridge, which is making its debut.

2023 North Carolina High School Athletic Association Dual Team Wrestling Championships

GREENSBORO, NC – The 2023 Dual Team Wrestling State Championships wrapped up with four teams crowned State Champions. Seven of the eight teams competing in this year's State Championships were returning regional champions. Only Newton-Conover, the 2A Western Champions, did not appear in the 2022 edition of the event.

Uwharrie Charter reached the State Championships for the fourth straight time, but defeated Avery County for the first time, winning the Eagles' second state title. The two teams were meeting for the third consecutive 1A Dual Team State Championship, but it was the Uwharrie grapplers that came away with the narrow 39-36 victory as Jaden Maness sealed the victory at 195 pounds, pinning Brandon Cabrera at the 3:20 mark of their bout to put the Eagles up 39-30 with one match remaining. Aldo Hernandez was selected as the 1A Most Valuable Wrestler for the 2023 Dual Team Championship, pinning Grant Reece in 132 lbs. in just 1:08.

The 2A Championship was a much tighter affair than last year's match, as Bunn kept things close against Newton-Conover. However, Newton grapplers overpowered the Wildcats in the mid-weights stretching out their lead and sealing a 51-18 victory. The win was the Red Devils' fourth Dual Team State Championship and their first since winning the title in 2016. Caiden Rowe was selected as the Most Valuable Performer from Newton-Conover, winning his match in the 160-pound division over Kevin Silverio by fall at 1:09.

Fred T. Foard rolled past Union Pines for the second consecutive year, winning the 3A Dual Team Championship and the Tigers' third consecutive Dual Team title. The Tigers dominated the match, winning eight of the 14 bouts by fall. Colby Mace was selected as the 3A Most Valuable Performer by Foard after battling back from injury to participate this season.

In the 4A Dual Team Championship, it was another rematch of last year's finalists. Northwest Guilford avenged a tough loss to Laney in the Finals a year ago by throttling the Buccaneers 52-24. The victory gave the Vikings their second State Championship all-time. Northwest got off to a fast start, winning by pin in five of the first six matches and adding a bonus point win by major decision in the other match. Nick Byrd led off the match with a huge win for Northwest in the heavyweight division over Michael Williams, stapling Williams to the mat just 55 seconds into the dual match. Byrd was selected as the 4A Most Valuable Performer for his leadoff win.

The NCHSAA is committed to promoting and highlighting outstanding sportsmanship at its events. The Association has partnered with NC Farm Bureau Insurance to award two sportsmanship awards at each of the NCHSAA's sanctioned championships. The NC Farm Bureau Sportsmanship Award winners for the 1A Duals were Caden Bond from Uwharrie Charter and Brandon Cabrera from Avery County. In 2A, the Sporsmanship Awards were presented to Nelson Aguilar from Bunn and Mike Xiong from Newton-Conover. The 3A Duals Sportsmanship Award winners were Dustin Maness from Union Pines and Sam Bolch from Fred T. Foard. The 4A Sportsmanship Awards were given to Mason Blue from Laney and Eli Pendergrass from Northwest Guilford.
